

- Burrow:** a hole or tunnel in the ground that an animal (such as a rabbit or gopher tortoise) makes to live in or for safety
- Cavity:** a hole or space inside something, such as a tree
- Cultivate:** to grow or raise (something) under conditions that you can control
- Diameter:** a straight line passing from side to side through the center of a body or figure, especially a circle or sphere
- Ecology:** a science that deals with the relationships between groups of living things and their environments
- Economy:** the process or system by which goods and services are produced, sold, and bought in a country or region
- Endangered species:** a type of animal or plant that has become very rare and that could die out completely
- Fuel:** vegetation that can burn; a material (such as coal, oil, or gas) that is burned to produce heat or power
- Harvest:** to gather or collect (something) for use
- Industry:** a group of businesses that provide a particular product or service
- Infrared:** producing or using rays of light that is invisible to human eyes, such as heat
- Lumber:** wooden boards or logs that have been sawed and cut for use typically in construction
- Management:** the act or process of deciding how to use something
- Natural regeneration:** natural process by which plants replace or re-establish themselves
- Prescribe:** to officially tell someone to use something as a remedy or treatment
- Reforestation:** the process of replanting an area with trees
- Renewable resource:** a resource which can be used repeatedly and replaced naturally
- Stand:** a group of trees growing near one another
- Steward:** one who is responsible, protects, or cares for something such as land or natural resources
- Sustainable:** involving methods that do not completely use up or destroy natural resources
- Terrain:** land of a particular kind
- Thermal:** of, relating to, or caused by heat
- Timber:** trees that are grown in order to produce wood
